All of this sporting involvement was in the midst of Old Boys' Day and Rosies Awareness Day – our community should be proud of what it can achieve with team effort.

Another highlight of the week was the 1st water polo team winning the Queensland Independent Schools Championship, establishing Iona as the number 1 water polo team in the state. Our 2017 team is strong, with the starting team all having played for Queensland at schools or age representative level.

Our Open AFL team won the Brisbane South Twilight Gala by default and now progress into the state knockout stages. Our Primary and Years 7 – 9 teams are still alive in their respective state knockouts as AFL flies the Iona flag across the state.
