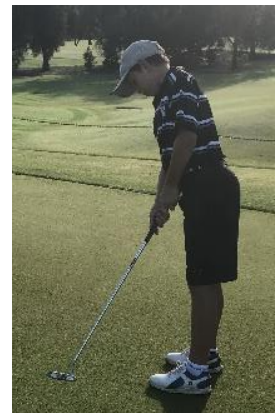

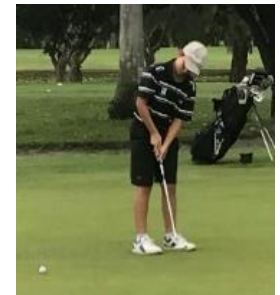
AIC Golf Championships
