Last weekend was highlighted by Iona winning the Queensland Schools Team Racing Sailing. Our Black team achieved 1st, the Whites 6th and Greys 8th. Our team will now head to Hobart for Nationals.

Volleyball was the only AIC sport to survive last Friday evening's deluge. Our performance against St Edmund's resulted in 10 aggregate wins and 2 losses. It was a strong College performance as we head to the final round of the AIC summer competition.

Our open netball team defeated Lourdes Hill College 22 – 17 in the first round of the Marian Cup, a popular initiative in our year.

This weekend's round versus Ashgrove will see the 2 strongest AIC sporting Colleges compete. It will be enthralling. In AFL, our Years 8/9 sit undefeated and the 1st XVIII 3rd. Volleyball sees Iona 1st or 2nd in 12 divisions, atop of the AIC aggregate ahead of Ashgrove and in a grandfinal situation in the 1st VI. Our 7A cricket team is our best performed senior team, while 5 of the Primary teams are undefeated including 4 Year 6 teams and the 5A boys. Get ready to "play your role".
