Our cross country squad continued their preparation for the AIC Championships and our elite swimmers competed in the National Age Championships in Adelaide. Amidst making individual finals at the National Swimming Championships, Hayden Wasiak won the 15 Years 200m breaststroke title and Gil Griffiths gained 4<sup>th</sup> in the 15 Years 200m freestyle. Riley Mather, Jack Martin and Gil Griffiths also won a relay bronze medal. All participants deserve congratulations.

Our facilities are now in excellent condition for winter. The continual improvement in the pool area recently saw the instalment of a new heating system that will allow our swim squad to train over winter under our full-time coaching staff.
