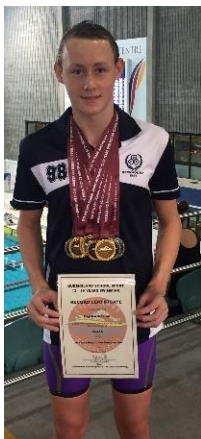
High Performance
