Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware the World Health Organisation has now declared the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) a pandemic. As a result, the Australian Government has advised all Australians to reconsider the need to travel overseas. The Government's warning, as at 14 March 2020 in part read:

"Regardless of your destination, age or health, if your overseas travel is not essential, consider whether now is the right time".

We urge you to follow the advice of the Australian Government and reconsider your need to travel overseas. If for some reason you, your family, or members of your household travel overseas while the situation with the coronavirus is still emerging, the College will require your son to self-isolate for 14 days. This is the case whether your son or another member of your household travelled overseas. It is important for our joint responsibility regarding the health and safety of all members of our community, that families abide by the College's requirement for students to remain at home for the self-isolation period. The College can continue to support students' learning while they are in self-isolation by providing some work for them to proceed with while they remain at home. This can be obtained by contacting your son's Head of House.

In the meantime, the College will continue to keep you informed about Coronavirus developments which impact upon College operations. The Compass App is a preferred method of communication. If you have not yet downloaded the App can I invite you to do so. Instructions on how to do this are included at the end of this letter.

I am sure that you are also aware that over the weekend the Prime Minister also made the following announcements:

- Schools will remain open and respond to local issues as required on the advice of health authorities.
- All international travel arrivals will be required to self-quarantine for a period of 14 days on arrival back in Australia.
- Social Distancing will continue to be a key response to this virus and to contain its spread no hand shaking, 1.5 metre safe distancing, etc
- Mass gatherings for 500+ people are not to proceed.

Members of the College staff continue to meet to determine Iona's response to the latest developments and the most recent advice. We have met today and made some decisions about future events for the remainder of Term 1 and into Term 2. These decisions have been made cognisant of the following factors:

- The importance that the College places on safety as our highest priority
- The potential for community transmission if the planned event was to go ahead
- Whether there is a capacity for appropriate social distancing to occur
- Whether or not the event is curriculum focused or related to the ongoing sustainability of the College
- Community expectations
