The three Iona College touch teams played wonderfully in the annual Queensland All Schools Championships. The 18's team won seven pool games, defeated St Mary's Toowoomba 6 – 5 in a drop-off (extra time) after being 1 – 3 down in the quarter-final, and then went down in a drop-off to Coombabah 4 – 5 in a close semi-final. Being semi-finalists for two years in a row is testament to the strength of this team.
