The Schools Fleet Racing regatta kicked off last Sunday with Iona entries making up 10 of the 51 competitive boats. Over 100 sailors hit the water, including 23 from Iona Sailing.



Sailing offers a unique opportunity for our team, with boats skippered and crewed by a paired combination from across all year levels 7 to 12. In fleet racing, it's every boat for themselves and the teamwork within the boat is crucial.

With all 51 boats fighting for position on the same start line in a mass start, the light and shifty wind conditions tested even our most experienced sailors. The jostling for position on the start line and at the top mark required a good mix of aggression and patience and made for interesting viewing.

The light winds in the morning meant racing was delayed until the conditions became more favourable. When racing got under way, 3 races were completed, with lona's best results coming in race 2, where 4 of our boats finished in the top 10.

With two more weeks of racing to complete the regatta, Iona sailors are well placed to take advantage of consistent sailing and finish high in the fleet standings.
