### 24 February

Our volleyballers led the way last week, winning 18 of 21 games played. Cricket was rain affected in the senior fixtures while solid efforts were displayed in primary cricket against Ambrose Treacy College. The Years 8/9, Year 7 and Year 6 AFL teams were successful and Fleet Racing sailing completed three rounds.

The traditional 50m freestyle sprints saw Benjamin Goedemans win "The Gaffney" (seniors) and Angus Cran sprinted home to win "The Sacre" (primary). Grandin won Primary interhouse swimming while Mazenod clinched the overall house championship. The swim season has seen elevated levels of participation and team spirit.

This week is large, one of the biggest of the summer season. AIC swimming takes place on Friday – motivation and commitment is complete, and performance now lies ahead with all involved waiting to "let their light shine". AFL teams take on Ashgrove with the 1<sup>sts</sup> playing at Iona Friday afternoon and St Patrick's in primary. The volleyball and cricket round will decide numerous premierships and both AIC aggregates – all teams need determined efforts. It is also photo day for teams playing at Iona.

This week also sees the opening rounds of the Mere de Dieu Cup between Ashgrove and Iona. The results of the ten 1<sup>sts</sup> games across all AIC sports count for the Cup, with the results of the three championship sports used if the results from 1<sup>sts</sup> are equal overall. Played since 2017, Iona last won the Cup in 2018.
