There was much to admire over the vacation. A number of elite swimmers competed at the National Age Championships with Benjamin Goedemans sensationally winning the 16 years 400m freestyle, gaining silver in the 16 years 200m freestyle and bronze in the 16 years 1500m freestyle. Hayden Wasiak, Matthew von Euw and Kyan Muir also made finals. The cross country squad attended a camp at the Gold Coast and also trained here at the College. Three rugby teams competed at the Ballymore Cup with 13 years and 15 years winning their respective competitions, a terrific effort against various Qld Colleges. Our sailing team also competed at the State Schools Championships, with our 2^{nds} achieving second place and 1^{sts} placing fourth.
