IONA COLLEGE FAMILY COMMITMENTS FOR 2022

Iona is first and foremost a community. For the past 64 years, the school, its facilities and the community have been forged from the wonderful generosity of our parents and friends in partnership with the Oblate Community. Numerous College activities and events can only take place with the assistance of parents/guardians on a roster basis. This assistance has the added bonus of building the sense of community within our College.

We ask families to consider how and where they can best contribute to the College in 2022. Please refer to the attached [Streams for Volunteering in 2022](#) document for further information, requirements and possible duties.

In lieu of this commitment, a Family Commitment Levy of \$130 per year per family is added to Term 4 fees. Parents who are unable to involve themselves in any of the activities listed are requested to pay the levy. However, if circumstances are difficult please contact the College Finance Department after receiving your Fee Account in Term 4.

Please note that some areas require a Blue Card prior to commencing in a volunteer capacity. In addition, with the "Vaccination requirements for workers in high risk settings" extending to education settings, only individuals who are up-to-date with their vaccinations are eligible to volunteer. This requirement has been added to our volunteer registration process for 2022.

All Iona parents/guardians are required to complete the 2022 volunteer registration and approval process via the link below by Friday 25 February.

You may select the stream you wish to volunteer in via the registration link above, or if you know you will be unable to volunteer in 2022, you may elect to choose to pay the \$130 Family Commitment Levy.

We recommend all parents/guardians complete the Volunteer Registration Form for 2022 as soon as possible to become approved volunteers, as we have volunteering opportunities commencing from the outset of the school year.
