



VOLUNTEER STREAMS FOR FULFILLING FAMILY COMMITMENTS IN 2022

All parents and carers will be required to be registered and approved as an Iona Volunteer prior to commencing in a voluntary role. Please note that only individuals who are up-to-date with their vaccinations are eligible to volunteer. SOME volunteer roles may also require other forms of registration such as blue cards or APHRA registration numbers. Please also note that grandparents, siblings and other family members may also fulfill the family commitment, but may be required to apply for a blue card to work with children.

Approved Iona College Volunteers will be contacted by the College to sign up to assist, according to the College's needs. This may only take place closer to the event date or at a time where volunteers are required to provide assistance.

A register of family involvement will be maintained throughout the year. Volunteers are reminded to sign an attendance register upon arrival at their volunteer area for recording purposes.

Community Activities and Events		
College Canteen / Provence Canteen	Assist with food preparation and serving. These canteens operate Monday to Friday offering breakfast, morning tea and lunch for students and staff. Food preparation takes place daily and many hands are required to ensure there are plenty of healthy choices to feed our growing boys.	Requires food handling induction on first visit.
Sport Canteens	Assist with staffing the various canteens at our sport facilities, i.e. volleyball / basketball at The Provence Centre, cricket & rugby at Davine Oval and Fuller Oval canteens.	Requires food handling induction on first visit.
IPAC Canteen	Assist with staffing the canteen/bar facilities for events in the Iona Performing Arts Centre (IPAC).	Requires food handling induction on first visit.
Library	Assist with shelving, contact covering or other activities as required in the St Eugene de Mazenod Resource Centre (Library); AND/OR Assist regularly in the College Archives.	Some tasks will include necessary training.
Parents & Friends Association	Attend monthly P&F Meetings as per the dates in the College Calendar; AND/OR Assist the P&F Committee with community functions and fundraising.	
Old Boys' Association	Assist the Old Boys' Committee with the organisation and running of Old Boys' functions.	
Music Supporters' Group (MSG)	Assist the MSG with activities/concerts and fundraising; AND/OR Attend monthly MSG Meetings as per the dates in the College Calendar; AND/OR Assist the Music Department with music cataloguing. Oblate Mission Action Day (OMAD)	Assist with activities and food/drinks stalls on OMAD. Please note that this does <u>not</u> include donations of baked goods.	Requires food handling induction for food stalls.

Art and Film Show	Assist with the preparation of the annual Visual Art, Film, TV and New Media Exhibition.	
Working Bee at Glendalough	Assist with the maintenance of Glendalough at the annual working bee held over one weekend, usually at the end of October.	
Rosies – Friends of the Street (External)	Assist with General Administration Duties, Stock Organisation or General Vehicle Care and Maintenance.	Rosies' staff will contact volunteers with further information.

The following areas require Blue Card or APHRA registrations:		
College Sports	Assist with coaching/managing/scoring for a sports team. Please note that this option is an expression of interest only and due to team numbers not all parents will be requested to assist. The College will contact parents if they require assistance. Parents should ensure they use another avenue to volunteer if they have not been contacted to assist. The Sport Department will provide a final list of parents who assist with coaching/managing/scoring for Family Commitment records.	Requires Blue Card
College Production and Drama Supporters' Group	Assist at Drama events or with the College Production. Volunteers will require a Blue Card as this area may involve students from other schools, plus assisting in dressing rooms, side-stage and with costuming.	Requires Blue Card
Iona Passion Play (External)	Support the Iona Passion Play by becoming a cast/crew member. Volunteers will require a Blue Card as this area may involve students from other schools, plus assisting in dressing rooms, side-stage and with costuming.	Requires Blue Card
Camp Nurse	Assist with nursing duties at school camps.	Requires APHRA Registration
