TEAM IONA

Cross country, mountain biking and winter sport involved many over the past week – determined effort provided excellent results from teams and individuals. Running long distances, enduring bike trails at high speeds and physically engaging with Padua College in sport were strongly achieved. All involved deserve congratulations.

At the annual AIC Cross Country Championships, our Primary team shared the aggregate shield and the Senior team were runners-up. It was our 18th Primary aggregate win in 23 years. We won the Year 6, 12 Years and 16 Years age divisions and individual efforts were exceptional with 8 podium finishes.

Our mountain bikers competed in the Darling Downs Rocky Trail event, winning both the aggregate and junior divisions. Our 34 riders were courageous and skilled. More events are planned.

In winter sport, our rugby team performances were strong and we shared results in both chess and football. Our 1st football team now share the premiership lead and need to win this Saturday against St Peters to secure the trophy. In so far as premiership and undefeated status, the following teams are in strong contention:
