The First XI produced their consistent best, and completed an undefeated season. Liam Carter scored a solid 52, and was well supported by Lachlan McClure with a classy 46, to set a challenging total of 231 runs. The bowlers did the job, with both Lachlan McClure and



Clancy Muniandy taking three wickets each.

especially Mr Wayne Niven, for his energy and drive in
preparing the players for a successful season.

A by-product of the training program for the Open boys is the Second XI also achieved a memorable double in the Open competition.

The year 8B team also claimed a premiership.

Other highlights of the last round were:
